



Camp Primary and Nursery School eSafety in school – notes for parents

Children and staff at Camp School are able to access the Internet through the Hertfordshire Grid for Learning (HGfL). The HGfL is a service supplied to all Hertfordshire Local Authority schools and children's homes.

The safety of children when using the Internet (eSafety) is of paramount importance to our school and to the HGfL. The school takes an active role in communication with pupils and parents on the safe use of ICT in school and at home, and all pupils and parents must agree to the Safe Use Agreement for the Internet and email.

We know that parents and guardians will also be concerned that their children stay safe when using the Internet at home and elsewhere. The HGfL website has a section dedicated to eSafety with advice to parents, governors, teachers and children. You will also find here a description of the particular measures taken to ensure that the HGfL is an appropriately protected Internet service for use in schools.
