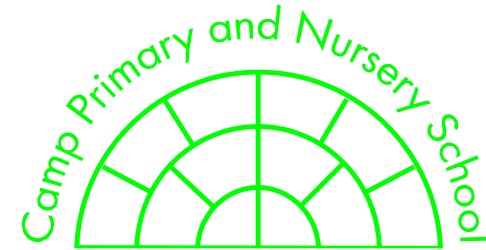


**HOMEWORK IS IMPORTANT TO US

### Year group expectations and organisation of homework

Year group	Expectations and organisation	Approximate time expectations* (in addition to reading)
Nursery	Sharing/reading books together every day	
Reception	Sharing/reading books together every day Short learning activity based on current theme once per week – including phonics and counting games Key words to learn	10-15 minutes per week
Year 1	Reading every day Key words to learn Literacy/Maths or topic based task once per week Long term extended homework project once per year	15-20 minutes per week
Year 2	Reading every day Key words to learn Literacy/Maths or topic based task once per week Long term extended homework project once per year	20-30 minutes per week

\*If you feel your child has spent more than the recommended time on an activity, please remember that it is not always necessary for them to complete it.

All year groups may occasionally send home 'Family Homework' tasks with a PSHE/Citizenship focus.

Year group	Expectations and organisation	Approximate time expectations* (in addition to reading)
Year 3	Reading every day Literacy and Maths task, or topic based task, once per week Long term extended homework project – twice per year	30-40 minutes per week
Year 4	Reading every day Literacy and Maths task, or topic based task, once per week Long term extended homework project – twice per year	45 minutes per week
Year 5	Reading every day Literacy, Maths and one topic based task once per week Long term extended homework project – once per term	1 hour per week
Year 6	Reading every day Literacy, Maths and one topic based task once per week Long term extended homework project – once per term SAM learning (Spring and Summer terms)	1-1 ½ hours per week
