Areas of Learning

As Historians we will be finding out what sea sides were like in the past. We will be looking at what the seaside was like 100 years ago and what made it such a popular place to go. We will be using photographs to help us find clues along the way.

As Geographers we will find out about sea sides around the world and those within Britain. This will involve looking into the key features of our local area and the seaside, and deciding how they are similar and different.

As Scientists we will be learning about seeds; how they are dispersed and how they grow. We will use the allotment, grow and nurture our own plants by watering and introducing useful mini-beasts and understand how food chains work.

As Computer Programmers we will be researching weather forecasts and creating a seaside storybook using Microsoft Office. We will also continue to practise our coding skills learned so far this year.

As Designers and Technologists we will be designing and making decorative puppet theatres out of cardboard boxes, complete with moving curtains. We will then be making the puppets for a puppet show.

As Artists we will be using different media to make a 3D seaside collage. We will also be using seaside objects to create prints.

As Musicians we will be composing a percussion piece for "We're Going on a Bear Hunt".

As Dancers we will learn to create simple movement sequences to show weather and seasons. We will also create a food chain dance linked with our Science topic..

As Gymnasts we will continue exploring large and small apparatus and creating and linking shapes and movements to create short sequences.

As games players we will be practising out teamwork and hand-eye coordination skills by taking part in some beach games such as volleyball, Frisbee and beach bowling and we will also practise athletics activities in preparation for Sports Day.

ENVIRONMENT

As **environmentalists** we will be learning about how plants grow and why they are important to us. We will grow fruit, vegetables and sunflowers!

We will also learning about keeping our beaches tidy and taking our rubbish home.

GLOBAL & LOCAL COMMUNITY

In our awareness of our **global and local communities** we will be looking at how we can recognise the geographical features of our school.

We will also be thinking about the places that our class have been to on holiday.

SPIRITUAL & MORAL DEVELOPMENT

As **spiritually & morally aware learners** we will identify the relationships in our lives.

We will think about the feelings that we might experience within different relationships, and talk about how we deal with these feelings.
