Tudor houses Victorian houses Celtic roundhouses. You can choose how to present your finding. Ask a grown up if you can borrow some coins to play your shopping game with.</p> 	<p>Investigate and compare house designs around the world. What materials are used? Why? What shapes are the houses? How are they different to English houses?</p>	<p>Re-write the story of the three little pigs by changing some aspects such as the characters and setting.
