


# My World; Your World EYFS Spring 2019



## Areas of Learning

**Communication and Language:** rhyme and alliteration, weather words, topics words, Phase 1-2 Phonics for Nursery, Phase 3 Phonics for Reception.

**Physical Development:** using our hands, using our playground, mark making and scissors, making models, ball skills and gymnastics and dance.

**Personal Social Emotional Development:** making friends and being friendly, working together, have a go & keep trying, becoming more independent.

**Literacy:** information books about transport and travel, people who help us, food around the world and story books such as: My World, Your World, Whatever next, Mr Gumpy's Outing, Handa's Surprise, Who Sank the Boat?, You Choose, Oi get off our Train. We will continue to develop our writing skills.

**Mathematics:** counting rhymes and songs, favourite food surveys, Surveys of how we travel to school. measuring distance and size. 2D and 3D shapes, problem solving.

**Understanding the World:** Weather, where people live, how we travel, transport, maps, my culture, animals around the world, food and clothes from different countries.

**Expressive Arts and Design:** colour mixing, making vehicles, houses, printing, weather collage, kites, songs about transport and travelling.
