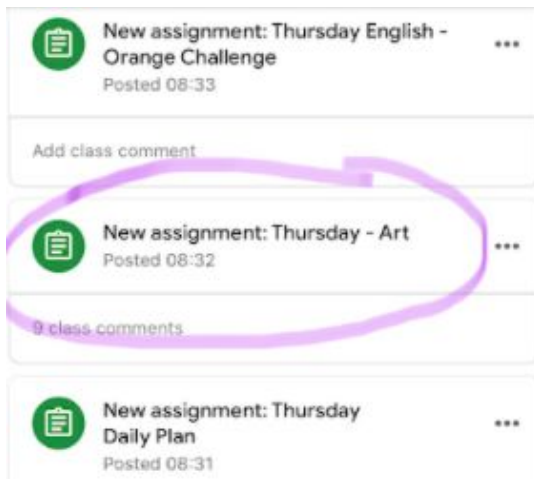


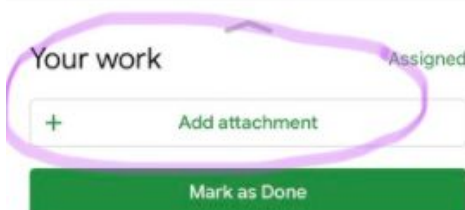
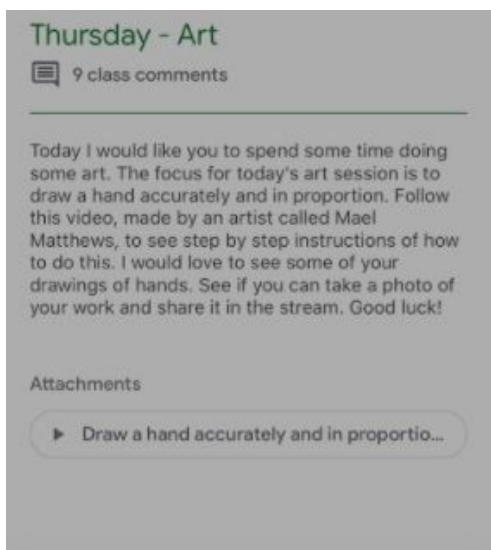
How to upload a photo to a classroom assignment in Google Classrooms

I've written these instructions as if you are using the google classrooms app on a smartphone, as I imagine this is the device you are most likely to be using to take a photo. You can of course still do this using a laptop or other device but the layout will look a little different.

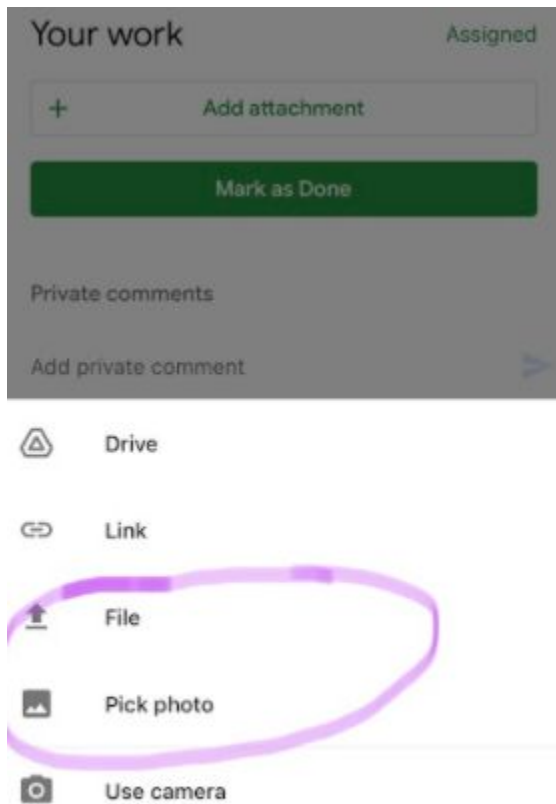
1. In the Year Six Google Classroom click on the assignment you want to add a photo to. (You can click on classwork first to find an assignment if you can't see it immediately)



2. Click on the arrow that points up saying 'Your work' (on a laptop this is to the right of the assignment description). Now click 'Add attachment'.



3. Select the file you want to add (click upload file and then click on the photo you want to add)



4. You should now see that your attachment is listed under 'Your work'. Click 'Hand in' to submit the file(s).
