



Sport at Camp School – Spring Term 2023

The start of the Spring term has seen lots of sporting activity, especially for Year 6, with many of them involved in football and netball matches, as well as an indoor athletics event.

Year 6 Sportshall (indoor) athletics

In January, 22 Year 6 children went along to Oaklands College to take part in an indoor athletics competition. They competed in a mixture of track and field events. The track events were all team based and included activities such as a 4x1 relay, a 2x2 relay, a Paarlau's relay (2 children running 6 laps in total), obstacle course and over and under relays. The field events included the javelin, chest push, standing long and triple jumps, and a standing jump. Camp School were one of eight schools taking part in the afternoon session.



Football and Netball matches

Recently, the boys and girls football teams have taken part in two tournaments at the Samuel Ryder Academy, playing on the school's Astroturf. Both teams did extremely well playing against much bigger schools who had entered the tournament. Overall, the boys team finished sixth and the girls team came third, so we should be very proud of them.

The school netball team also played their first match of the Spring season, losing a closely fought game to St Adrian's Primary School 7-4.

Herts Cross Country Championships

The Herts Cross Country Championships were held on Saturday 4th February at Verulamium Park. Some boys and girls from Years 5 and 6 took part with the race being around one mile and quite steep and muddy in places. All runners did brilliantly.
