- Provide as much support as we can to help your child do their best at all times and to meet their full potential.
- Provide opportunities for your child to practise what they have learnt in school at home.
- Regularly share the progress of your child through parent's consultations, reports and open evenings.
- Contact you if there is a concern regarding attendance and punctuality.
- Let you know about any concerns or problems that might affect your child's work or behaviour and what the school is doing to address any such concerns.
- Keep you informed about school activities through letters home, newsletters and notices about special events.
- Be open and welcoming at all times and offer opportunities for parents to become involved in the daily life of the school.
- Respect the confidentiality of information regarding each child,
- Provide extra-curricular opportunities that will further enrich your child's learning and wellbeing.
- Help children to recognise and protect themselves from online abuse or bullying and misuse of social media to ensure that they keep safe when online.

As a parent/carer I will:

- Ensure my child comes to school every day, on time and prepared for learning.
- Inform the school about any concerns that might affect my child's learning, behaviour or ability to take part in school activities.
- Inform the school of any medical issues for my child and provide relevant reports.
- Share with the school the involvement of any external professional help to ensure everyone works together for the child's benefit.
- Ensure my child is wearing clothing in line with school uniform recommendations and that their PE kit is in school every day.
- Collect my child punctually and advise the school if I am going to be late or if there is a change to the pick-up arrangements at the end of the day.
- Work with the school to ensure that the school's policies including guidelines for attendance and behaviour are maintained.
- Support my child with their homework and other opportunities for home learning.
- Attend parents' evenings and other discussions about my child's progress.
- Follow the school policy and procedures relating to the use of mobile devices, social media and online safety.
- Support my child to remain safe and to be responsible when accessing the internet, online resources, mobile and digital technologies. This includes ensuring my child is accessing age-appropriate materials, appropriate parental controls are in place and the school's online safety agreement has been discussed with and signed by my child.
- Show respect for all members of the school community, irrespective of their gender, sexuality, ethnic origin, religion or ability.
- Inform the school should my child's needs or family situation change.

As a child attending the school I will:

- Come to school regularly and on time, wearing my school uniform and bringing with me my PE kit,
- Follow our golden rules where:
 - We are kind.
 - We show respect for ourselves, others and the environment.
 - We keep ourselves and others safe.
 - We try our best with our learning.
- Be responsible for my school and home learning.
- Take good care of the school building, equipment and grounds.
- Reflect on my behaviour and learning and learn from all experiences.
- Follow the school's guidance in relation to online safety, which includes learning how to be safe and be responsible when accessing the internet, online resources, mobile and digital technologies, and what to do if I have any concerns, problems or need help.
- Tell a member of staff if I am worried or unhappy.
