### **Year 5 trip to the Science Museum, London**

As part of our Science topic on 'Forces', we have planned a trip to the Science Museum in London (<https://www.sciencemuseum.org.uk/>) on **Friday 8<sup>th</sup> December** for the children in Year 5. Aside from being able to explore the overall museum, we have specifically booked the class to participate in two sessions: (1) Wonderlab involves live science shows and demonstrations where pupils learn about how science and maths shapes their everyday lives; (2) Feel the Force: A dynamic show all about forces and magnets for Key Stage 2 pupils.

We will be travelling by coach to London and we will be leaving at **8:40am**. Therefore, the children will need to be in school by **8:20am** on Friday 8<sup>th</sup> December, please. The children will return to school by **4:00pm**. The children will need to be dressed in their normal school uniform and will also need to bring along:

- A Warm coat / Waterproof jacket.
- A couple of drinks (not fizzy).
- A packed lunch and snacks (if not having a free school packed lunch).

Please use the Arbor online system to make payment and to give consent for your child to go on the trip by **Friday 24<sup>th</sup> November**. The cost of the trip is **£22.60** per child, which will cover coach travel and the cost of the "Feel the Force" show – a school booking allows us free entry to the museum and into the Wonderlab.

Please be aware that, should not enough parents contribute to the cost of the trip meaning the costs are not covered, the trip may have to be cancelled. If any parents would like to see how the cost of the trip has been worked out, please ask at the office where further information will be available.
