Dear parents and carers,

Year 2 trip to the Natural History Museum, Tring

Linked to our recent Explorers' topic and previous science work on habitats we have arranged a class visit to the Natural History Museum at Tring on Thursday 23rd May. The children will take part in a Polar Expedition workshop and we will also spend time exploring the galleries in groups.

We will be travelling by coach, leaving after registration and returning before 3pm, so children can be dropped off and collected at the usual times.

As all children in KS1 are entitled to have a free school meal, we will provide a free packed lunch from school for every child. We will ask the children to choose which sandwich they would like a few days before the trip. If you would prefer to provide your own packed lunch then please let us know by Thursday 16th May.

The children will need to be dressed in their normal school uniform and will also need to bring along:

- A coat
- A filled water bottle
- A healthy snack (no nuts or sesame please)

Please use Arbor to make the online payment and to give consent for your child to go on the trip by Monday 13th May 2024. The cost of the trip is £16.40 per child, which will cover coach travel and suggested donation to the museum. Please be aware that, should not enough parents contribute to the cost of the trip, the trip may have to be cancelled. If any parents would like to see how the cost of the trip has been worked out, please ask at the school office where further information will be available.
